
**2015 - 2018 CHALLENGES**

- ☐ Development of a performance appraisal process that will support staff training and development.




## STAFFING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES CONTINUED

- Development of Makerspace centres (Leamington)



The proposed 2019 budget supports the following objectives:

- ☐ To address the residual impacts of the 2017 0% budget due to the 2016-2017 strike
- ☐ To support the 2019 ECLB operational projects.

The Essex County Library Board proposes increase of 4.6% for the 2019 budget year

**2019 BUDGET PROPOSAL** 



- ☐ Salary Increase of 1.9% to meet contractual obligations
- ☐ Benefits increase of 4.6% to support cost of insurances, health and wellness benefits and pension contributions
- □ Proposed mileage costs support staff ability to provide outreach and community programs

## The Essex County Library will contribute:

- \$28,000 Vehicle Reserve for the purchase of secondary vehicle
