Goal 1: Access

Launched the Windsor-Essex **By-Names Prioritized List** (BNPL) in May 2018

- Number of Community Agencies partnered on the BNPL
- Total number of households 168 who are actively experiencing chronic homelessness as of December 31, 2018

Goal 2: Person Centred Supports

Support was enhanced in 2018 due to an increase in staff



269 People housed (since July 2015)

WEHC participants graduated from the program

Since April 2015 **Housed Participants** saw positive changes in:

- Participation 280 changes in employment, training, recreation, and social participation



Voluntary Trusteeship Program

88% improved confidence managing finances 100% of program participants have SECURED SAVINGS

Increased use of shelter diversion to ensure housing policies are supporting housing sustainability





Other Initiatives

The Housing Stability Plan (HSP)

- Went from homelessness 23% to housed
- Were able to maintain 77% their housing
- Received Rent Assistance 709
- Average Utility Assistance \$662 per household

2018 Point in Time (PiT) Count

The Point in Time Count is a non-identifying census to gather demographic information (e.g. age, gender, veteran or Indigenous Status). It is a street count of homlessness at any "point in time" on a specific day within a community.
