Purpose

The purpose of this report is to provide County Council information and recommendations pertaining to tender results for a culvert rehabilitation project to be undertaken as part of the 2021 Rehabilitation Program.

Background

The 2021 structure rehabilitation program includes the complete replacement of the culvert on County Road 27 at Centre Branch No. 47 Drain located in the Town of Kingsville.

The works are intended to occur during the summer of 2021 with an anticipated start date by the end of July.

Discussion

The tender process utilized electronic bidding and received six (6) submissions.

The following is a summary of the tenders received. All amounts do not include H.S.T.

County Road 27 – Culvert over Centre Branch #47 Drain

South Shore Contracting of Essex County Inc.	\$448,905.00
Sterling Ridge Infrastructure Inc.	\$456,189.00
Rudak Excavating Inc.	\$472,200.00
Matassa Incorporated	\$517,700.99
Facca Incorporated	\$669,890.00

The electronic submissions were evaluated for compliance with specifications and mathematical accuracy. The submissions were complete with no discrepancies identified.

Financial Implications

The 2021 Rehabilitation Program includes sufficient funds to replace the concrete box culvert on County Road 27 at Centre Branch No. 47 Drain.

Recommendation

That Essex County Council award the tender for Project Number 118-2021 County Road 27 Culvert over Centre Branch No. 47 Drain to D'Amore Construction (2000) Ltd. for a total tender amount of \$439,330.00 plus H.S.T.
