

The Corporation of the County of Essex By-Law Number 2022-08

A By-law to Authorize the Execution of a Lease Agreement between The Corporation of the County of Essex, The Essex-Windsor Solid Waste Authority and Christopher Malott Farming Enterprises Inc.

Whereas the Corporation of the County of Essex (The County), on behalf of the Essex-Windsor Solid Waste Authority (the Authority), is the registered owner of vacant farm lands in the vicinity of the Essex-Windsor Regional Landfill;

And Whereas The Authority, The County and Christopher Malott Farming Enterprises Inc. (The Tenant) are currently parties to a lease agreement dated May 3, 3016, whereby the Tenant is leasing certain vacant farm land, more particularly described in the lease agreement authorized by By-law 28-2016;

And Whereas the current lease agreement was set to expire on October 31, 2021, with a provision to allow three optional one year extensions, if mutually agreed upon by all parties;

And Whereas the Authority and Tenant agreed, to exercise the **first** one-year extension for the period November 1, 2021 to October 31, 2022;

And Whereas the Authority and Tenant have agreed, one year in advance of the current lease agreement expiration date, to exercise the **second** one-year extension for the period of November 1, 2022 to October 31, 2023;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the County of Essex hereby enacts as follows:

1) That the Warden and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute the Lease Extension Agreement between The County, The

Authority and The Tenant, a copy of which is attached hereto, and affix the Corporate seal thereto.

- That the term of this Lease Extension Agreement shall be for a period of one year commencing on the 1st day of November, 2022 and expiring on the 31st, day of October, 2023, with one optional one-year extension remaining, if mutually agreed upon by all parties, on the terms and conditions as set out in the original Lease.
- 3) This By-law shall come into force and take effect after the final passing.
