At its Special Council Meeting held on November 15, 2021, Michelle Bishop, Essex-Windsor Solid Waste Authority, General Manager, presented the Administrative Report entitled Essex-Windsor Solid Waste Authority (EWSWA) Regional Food and Organics Waste Management Project and recommended a regional organics initiative with local municipalities. This Administrative Report was brought to its Regular Council Meeting of December 6, 2021, to allow Essex Town Council an opportunity to further discuss the Town of Essex interest in participating in a regional approach to the proposed Food and Organics Waste Management Project.
