




In our nation's hours of greatest need, The Essex and Kent Scottish gave it their all

- Defending what all of us today hold dear




The Government funds only a limited portion of our commemorative initiatives

- Fundraising Campaign launched to fund these important initiatives in perpetuity.




Your support will allow us to sustain our Foundation's capital base in perpetuity
