# CANADA'S FASTEST GROWING EV SUPPLY CHAIN

Recent investments in Windsor-Essex

- Future Home to Canada's largest giga-factory: NextStar Energy Inc. (2024)
  - \$5 billion-dollar joint venture between LG Energy Solution and Stellantis N.V.
  - 2,500 direct good paying jobs and several thousand indirect jobs
- In 2022, **Stellantis** announced **two new electrified vehicle platforms for the Windsor Assembly Plant** and a **100,000-square-foot electric battery lab** that will be added to the company's Automotive Research and Development Centre. The new battery lab will be central to Stellantis' R&D operations in North America and serve the company's worldwide needs for technology, process and product development.
- South Korea's **DongShin Motech Ltd.** announced investment of \$90 million on a new battery casing facility to supply the \$5-billion NextStar Energy battery factory.
- Flex-lon Battery and Innovation Centre (a division of Flex-n-Gate) has opened in the region and will be the companies lead R&D facility for battery design, development and testing. The company will invest \$40 million into the facility and equipment to become a premier battery testing location.



# WHAT THIS MEANS FOR WINDSOR-ESSEX

# INVESTMENT PIPELINE – MAKE SURE YOUR COMMUNITY IS INVESTMENT READY

- Be fully serviced or readily serviceable (electricity, gas, waste, wastewater, telecommunications) and free of major development constraints
- Have completed assessment due diligence, including environmental site assessments and archaeological assessments
- Come with detailed site information, including ownership and title, property survey, zoning, road and rail access, utilities and servicing letters, topographical maps of the developable area, and a community profile
- Municipal CIP tax incentives, development costs, etc...



### IWE IS LEADING THE SHIFT FROM AUTOMOTIVE TO AUTOMOBILITY

- Invest WindsorEssex's Automobility and Innovation (A&I) department was created in 2017 as a response to the changing nature of the auto industry across the region from the Internal combustion engine to the electric vehicle.
- Since 2018 the A&I dept has secured **\$16M in provincial and federal funding** to support the transition of our local economy to automobility.



- The A&I dept. is a 100% funded through Provincial and Federal contributions.
- This dept. is a value add to the Windsor Essex region and does not leverage County and City core contributions.
- Staff, programming, and equipment are purchased through grant funding that the dept. has secured.



### IWE IS LEADING THE SHIFT FROM AUTOMOTIVE TO AUTOMOBILITY

#### Automotive Capital to Automobility Capital







Home to the **Canadian Automobility Hub**: Canada's first EV ramp-up factory offering a suite of resources and services to enable and support entrepreneurs and businesses interested in advancing the market for electric, zero-emission, connected and automated vehicle technology. Designated as 1 of 7 Ontario **Regional Technology Development Sites** specializing in advanced simulation, virtual reality and automotive cybersecurity. Funded by the Ontario Vehicle Innovation Network (OVIN). Home to **Canada's largest publicly** accessible virtual reality (VR) **CAVE**: The Invest WindsorEssex (IWE) VR CAVE serves as a commercialization tool to support

mobility companies with free simulation testing and virtual prototyping services.



### IWE IS LEADING THE SHIFT FROM AUTOMOTIVE TO AUTOMOBILITY



- In 2022 the A&I team worked with Habitat for Humanity and the Bridge Youth Centre in Learnington to showcase the simulated design of a 3D printed home as part of a first of its kind in Canada housing project lead by Habitat for Humanity Windsor-Essex and in partnership with the University of Windsor.
- The IWE team used the VR CAVE to identify how the new design would ultimately look and allowed builders to perform an accessibility audit on the homes to ensure they are fully accessible prior to construction.



- The A&I dept. is the eXtended Reality partner for the Automotive Parts Manufacturers Association' (APMA) Project Arrow. The A&I team worked to create a high-fidelity model of the vehicle through the VR CAVE and assist in the simulation work as the model was being developed.
- Most recently the A&I team created an Augmented Reality application to showcase all the partners and companies (Including County of Essex suppliers – ie. Ettractive from Tecumseh) providing components, technologies, and support for the vehicle.

  - \$700,000 program/grant funding, 30 expansions, 55 start ups, 153 jobs, 380 consultations, 60 grant recipients, 712 outreach, 600+ workshop participants



### **ESSEX COUNTY BUSINESS SUPPORT**

- SBEC's client **Cedar Valley (Oldcastle)** and BRE's client **Uni-Fab (Leamington)** received \$5.3 million through Jobs and Growth Fund creating 55 jobs and improving manufacturing capabilities in Windsor-Essex.
- BRE client **CapsCanada (Lakeshore)** announced \$5 million in funding for an expansion project that will create 50 jobs – total project investment of \$18.5 million.





## ESSEX COUNTY BUSINESS SUPPORT

- SBEC has extended its service locations to further support businesses across Essex County.
- Since the start of 2022 BRE has supported **11 clients in Essex County** that have planned and announced expansions with a total value of over **\$90 million**, generating **285 new jobs**.
- BRE continues to work with Hydro One, IESO, and Enbridge, in support of critical energy infrastructure projects, necessary to the retention and expansion of Essex County businesses, and the attraction of new investment.
- BRE continues to work with our community partners to support key projects that impact our Essex County (Regional) businesses - Windsor Essex Local Immigration Partnership (WE LIP), WFWE.
