



The Corporation of the County of Essex

By-Law Number 2023-50

A By-law to authorize the execution of an Agreement with His Majesty the King in right of the Province of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation regarding the expansion of King's Highway 3 between County Road 23 and County Road 34.

Whereas the Ministry of Transportation is proceeding with the expansion of King's Highway 3 from 1.1 km east of County Road 23 easterly to 1.1 km east of County Road 34, all in the Town of Kingsville;

And whereas prior to commencing work on the expansion of King's Highway 3, the Ministry of Transportation requires that the Corporation of the County of Essex enter into an Agreement formalizing the Parties respective rights and obligations;

And whereas it is deemed expedient to authorize the execution of the said Agreement;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the County of Essex hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That the Warden and the Clerk be and the same are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with His Majesty the King in right of the Province of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Transportation regarding the expansion of King's Highway 3 between County Road 23 and County Road 34, to affix the seal of the Corporation of the County of Essex thereto, and to execute such further and other documents as may reasonably be required and necessary to give effect to this By-law;
- 2) That the said Agreement, once executed, shall be appended to and form part of this By-law; and
