By-Law Number 2023-57

A By-law to Authorize the Acquisition of Certain Lands for improvements to County Road 43 from County Road 42 to South of the CP Rail Line.

Whereas the Corporation of the County of Essex wishes to proceed with the completion of certain improvements to County Road 43 from County Road 42 to South of the CP Rail Line, including realigning County Road 43 to align with Concession 11 and the widening of County Road 43 north of County Road 42;

And whereas it is necessary to acquire certain lands along County Road 43 to accommodate the said improvements to County Road 43.

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the County of Essex hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That Administration for the Corporation of the County of Essex be and are hereby authorized, to take any and all steps necessary to acquire ownership of the lands described as Parts 1 through 9, inclusive, on Reference Plan 12R-28827 and Parts 1 through 11, inclusive, on Reference Plan 12R-29051, including entering into Agreements of Purchase and Sale or proceeding with an Application for Approval to Expropriate Land pursuant to the provisions of the *Expropriation Act*.
- 2) That the Warden and the Clerk for the Corporation of the County of Essex be and is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents that may be necessary to complete the acquisition of the said lands referenced above and that may be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this By-law.
- 3) This By-law shall come into force and take effect after the final passing.
