Purpose

The purpose of this Administrative Report (the "**Report**") is to provide County Council with a report on the first quarter ("**Q1**") procurement activities for 2025 (as required by Section 4.9(b) of the County's Procurement Policy).

Background

The Procurement Services Division ensures the procurement of goods and services are open, fair, transparent and compliant with the County's Procurement Policy.

In accordance with Section 4.9(b) of the County's Procurement Policy, this report provides Council with a summary of contract awards greater than \$500,000 that were within budget and free of irregularities. While the policy assigns this reporting responsibility to Department Heads, it is reasonable given the day to day responsibilities of the Procurement Group that they prepare this report to ensure consistency and efficiency in reporting.

Usually, any procurement matters outside of the parameters of this Report will be addressed in regular reporting from either the Department Head or the County Treasurer. However, to the date of this Report, there have been no procurement matters completed that have exceeded the amount budgeted and approved by council in the 2025 Budget.

Furthermore, to date all procurement reporting requirements under the policy, that was approved in February of 2024, have been met. The Treasurer reported in September 2024 on procurements that exceeded budget by less than 10%, detailing how the excess amounts were covered.

The annual procurement report, required by procurement policy section 4.9(a), summarizing all procurement activities was presented to Council in November 2024.

This report fulfills the County's procurement reporting obligations and supports transparency in the County's procurement activities.
