Thank you for your letter of support for the expansion of Highway 3. I welcome the opportunity to respond.

The ministry recognizes the importance of promoting trade and transportation to the Windsor-Essex region and is pleased to hear that a number of local organizations support Phase 3 expansion of Highway 3 between the Town of Essex and Learnington.

Ontario remains committed to finishing our plans to widen Highway 3 between Windsor and Learnington to four lanes. To date, we have already invested nearly \$50 million to widen 13 km of Highway 3 between Windsor and the Town of Essex.

In your letter, you suggest that the Government of Canada's National Trade Corridors Fund could be a source of funding for Phase 3 widening of Highway 3. The ministry is aware of this new funding initiative, and has already provided projects for consideration under the initial intake for the program.
